BOARD CANDIDATES NEEDED!

The GRE Board consists of 15 members: 3 clergy and 12 lay persons. Each board member serves a 3-year term, starting in January following the election. Five new board members are elected to replace the retiring members – 1 clergy and 4 lay persons. The board should consist of members from each area in the Great River Emmaus Community. The GRE Board meets once a month, usually the 4th Monday evening of the month.

To be eligible to be a board member, you must have been on an Emmaus Walk. As a member of the board, conference room team and behind the scenes volunteering experience is an added bonus when discussing the needs of our community and the walks themselves.

The election is conducted in the fall of each year. The nominees will be listed in the fall newsletter for the entire community to vote on. Election of officers and committee chair assignments happen at the January meeting of the new board. The current committees and co-chairs are listed on the back of this Update, along with the year they serve through. It is important to have a good mix of men and women from each area within our GRE community.

Details regarding committees will be explained to the newly elected board members when they meet with the entire board during the first meeting in January following the election. Please pray for your GRE Community and Board.

Board candidates are needed. Prayerfully consider board participation. And, if you know someone who would do a good job representing your community and furthering the Emmaus ministry/experience – please encourage them to apply by September 30.



As members of the GRE community, we are asking you to prayerfully consider applying to run as a prospective board member. If you are not called to do so, please encourage someone you know to participate.

Each candidate needs to send a brief biography/summary of who they are and why they would be a good board member candidate. Following are some examples a person might submit: Name – Family highlights – City you live in – Church you attend – Occupation – Walk(s) you have been on – How you have served on walks (conference room, kitchen, Agape chapel, Workroom, etc.) – Why you want to serve as a GRE Board member.
